- Copy of clinical placement reports (two most recent reports)

Application Guidelines for Enrolled Nurse Graduate Positions

Position appointments are based on staffing requirements throughout the year. Graduates are rolled into the current Graduate Program at their time of employment. Unit rotations may or may not occur based on the staffing requirements at the time of employment.
